Learning Overview



Reading, Writing, Spelling & Grammar

We will be exploring 'The Lost Happy Endings' in English, focusing on creating a 'twisted tale' and a persuasive letter. We will be working on fronted adverbials, expanded noun phrases, apostrophes for possession, pronouns to avoid repetition and fluency of writing. In shared reading, we will be continuing to work on inference, vocabulary, effect of author's use of language, summarizing and the close reading of texts.

Maths- Fluency, Reasoning & Problem Solving

In maths, we will be recalling our prior learning and using what we already know to build on our knowledge and learn and remember more. Our focus this will be on written methods to add and subtract, including using exchange to 'carry' numbers. We will also continue our work on 2D shape, position and direction, area and statistics.
