# Reading, Writing, Spelling & Grammar

In English, we will be focusing on persuasive writing this half term and learning how to use fronted adverbials and subordinate openers to help us to structure our writing.

We will also be creating our own refugee narrative based on the book, 'The Journey'. We will be continuing to learn about and implement expanded noun phrases, varied nouns and apostrophes to show possession to help us.

## Maths- Fluency, Reasoning & Problem Solving

In maths, we will be continuing our work on 2D shape (including learning about different types of triangles and quadrilaterals) before moving on to learn about position and direction, area, statistics and measures. We will also be completing daily times table work in class – please encourage your child to use Times Table Rockstars at home.

#### Science

We will be learning about living things and their habitats. In this topic we will explore classification and grouping of living things.

We are going to investigate how environments change and the danger this poses to living things.
